Educative Project

NEEDS:

The educational project is a huge opportunity for the guys that come out of Pediatrics as it allows them to fit into the local community. The basic need is to ensure these children, once they are old enough, to not live in conditions of poverty and hardship and social marginalization. To do this there are needed at least 17 educators and one psychologist present within the context of Kimbondo. Furthermore in order to ensure the widest possible hospitality by the Pediatric Foundation, it is essential that older kids have the opportunity to find a place in society to ensure a replacement that will allow abandoned children to be welcomed.

CONTEXT:

The economic situation of the Democratic Republic of the Congo does not allow the majority of the guys, once out of Pediatrics, to live their lives in a dignified manner, forcing them to live in conditions of social exclusion and poverty. Without adequate education and training, these guys are destined to live in such poor conditions for the rest of their lives.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE:

Training and preparation of the older boys in the Pediatrics and subsequent inclusion in the society to which they belong. The project aims in particular to let grow a sense of responsibility and independence that often in boys who have lived experiences of abandonment and growth in structures like Pediatrics, completely different from the external reality, are not present.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Increase in competent, practical and theoretical knowledge for the boys.
2. Increase in employment opportunities for young people.
3. Increasing the sense of responsibility and functional autonomy to self-determination.
4. Creation of new employment opportunities for young people and educators.
5. Decrease of social exclusion for young and older guys.
6. Increase in the total number of children placed through a correct change of the boys.

BUDGET:

For 1 educator: 3.000 € per year

Total educators needed: 17

For one psychologist: € 6,000 per year
