Intensive Care Pavilion

NEEDS:

To improve the quality of the service offered by the Pediatrics is essential to create a new pavilion for the Intensive Care, as well as adequate training of personnel for the management of the pavilion and emergencies.

CONTEXT:

The health situation of the town of Mont 'Ngafula is characterized by a series of problems that make services and quality of health care unable to meet all the needs of the population. Access to health is low because of the financial unsustainability of the population and also because of the accessibility of the population to essential medicines is low. Funding of the State and the provinces to the health sector are scarce, staff training is inadequate and the management of health information is not orderly and steady.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE:

Training and preparation of medical and nursing staff and the construction of a pavilion of Intensive Care and Emergency Management.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

1. Ensuring a service of intensive therapy effective and efficient to serve with specialized personnel adequately trained, with suitable infrastructure and quality material, to drastically reduce the mortality rate of hospitalized patients from 35% to below 10 %.
2. Creation of new employment opportunities in the health field in the reference area.
3. Speed up the process that will see the Pediatric Foundation of Kimbondo become a general hospital with consequent possibility of access to government funds.

BUDGET:

For the training of medical employers: 50.000 € per year

For the creation of the pavilion: 400.000 €
